OUR JOBS

The Vermejo Park Ranch high season runs February to November. Our annual hiring window is January through late April. We are hiring for both management and non-management positions.

BARTENDER

Advanced knowledge in beer, wine and spirits a plus. This position generally closes the nightly Food and Beverage operations including cleaning the bar area.
